The long and glorious history of the university is reflected in its alumni. Many graduates proudly bear the titles of national, European, Olympic and world champions. Some of them become record-holders, famous coaches and scientists.

Many famous sportsmen, who studied here, made their contribution to the success of Soviet and Russian sports, and this tradition goes on with the current students.



The university has a campus with 3 academic buildings, 3 hostels, one of which is a hotel-type hostel with a conference hall and a canteen, a library and a cafeteria.



The university has all the necessary sport facilities, which make it possible to go in for a great variety of sports: a stadium, an ice-palace, a swimming pool, an indoor track-and-field stadium, multiple gyms, sports grounds, a rollerdrome and a tennis court.





The university stadium sits 2000 spectators. It hosts major football and track-and-field tournaments and solemn ceremonies.

The university swimming pool has 2 basins, one of which meets the Olympic standards, being 50m long, a complex for balneology therapy, a conference hall, a gym and a canteen. It hosts major tournaments in swimming and diving, and students have swimming in their curriculum.





The university ice-palace, built in 2014, sits 1188 spectators. Its hockey rink is 61m long and 30m wide, there are 6 locker rooms, a choreography hall, lecture rooms and a canteen. It hosts major tournaments in hockey, speed-skating and figure-skating.

The indoor stadium includes a track-and-field arena with multiple running tracks, a shot-putting sector, sectors for hammer, discus and javelin throwing and sectors for long jumping, triple jumping and pole vaulting. There is also a tennis court.





Now the university has 5 departments and 20 chairs of theory and methods of different kinds of sports and some sport-related subjects.



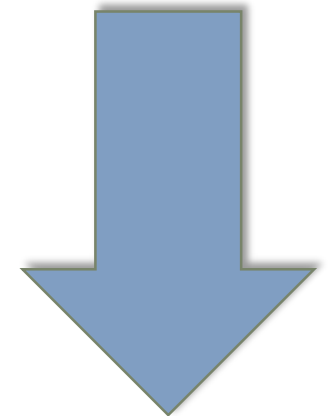
The departments of physical culture and sports and physical culture and recreational technologies train experts in the field of physical education.

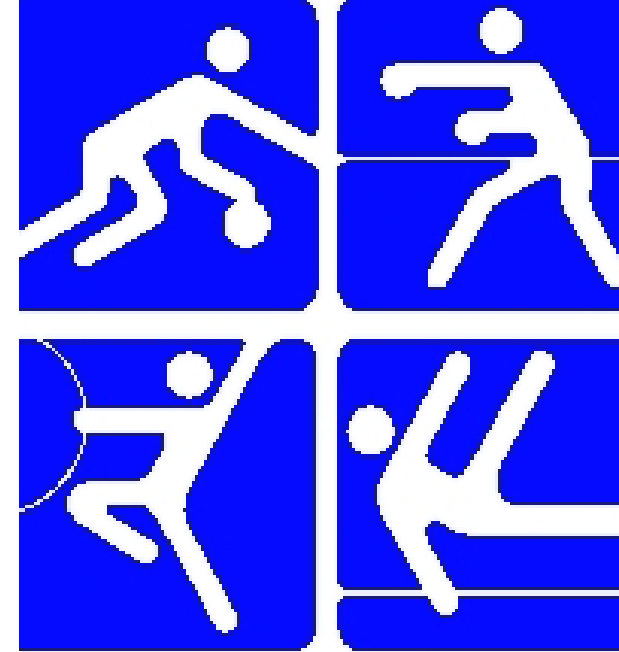
There are departments of further education, individual educational technologies and an extra-mural department.



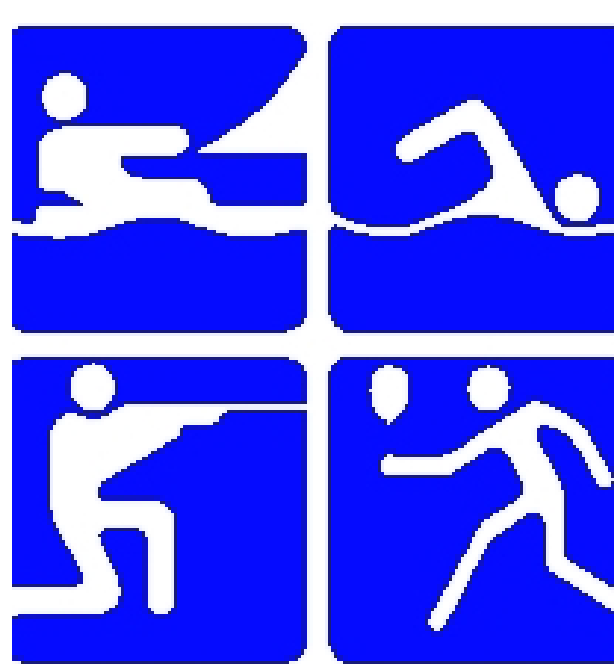
All the chairs of the university carry out educational programs for full-time, part-time, individual and additional education.

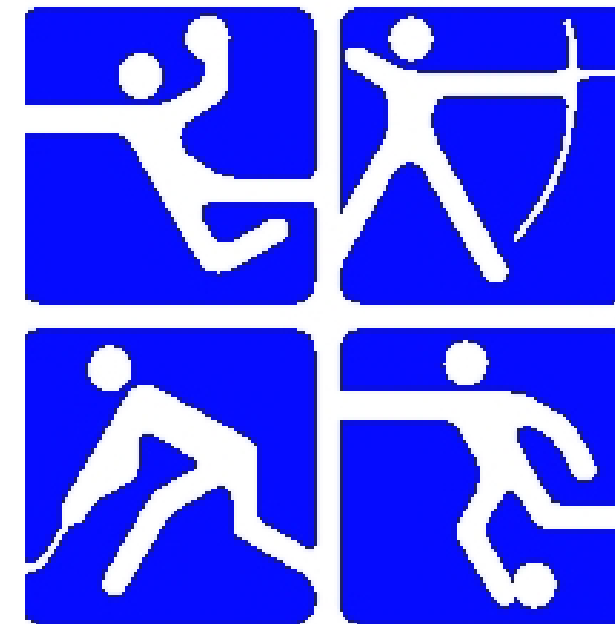
